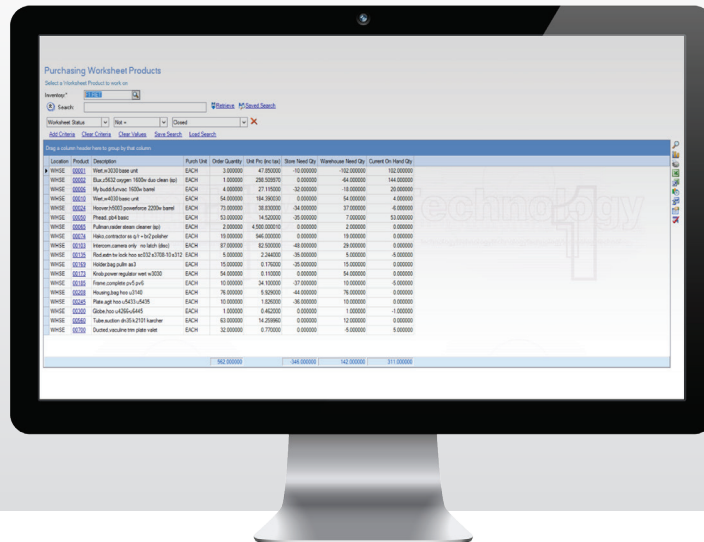


Supply Chain Replenishment

Automate the creation of both external orders and internal transfers with a single solution.



Key features and benefits

Fully integrated

The Replenishments module builds upon the TechnologyOne Inventory module by providing the facility to calculate the quantities of stock required in both store and warehouse locations. The following documents can be automatically generated for the required stock:

- Transfers from the warehouse to the stores
- Purchase requisitions to deliver to the warehouse
- Purchase requisitions to deliver direct to the stores

Generate transfers

Internal replenishment functionality is provided through a replenishment worksheet. This provides the same calculations as the purchasing worksheet, but the end result is a transfer of stock from the warehouse to the stores. Options are provided to track stock in transit.

Generate requisitions to suppliers

External replenishment functionality is provided through a purchasing worksheet. These allow suggested reorder quantities to be calculated and reviewed. Commitments such as stock on order and stock that is required for future requisitions are all taken into the calculations. Requisitions can be generated to deliver to the warehouse or directly to the store locations.

Recalculate reorder point

The TechnologyOne solution provides for the reorder point against each product to be optionally, automatically updated. Reorder profiles allow the configuration of the number of weeks' stock holding for each product or group of products, and then this is factored against the average weekly issues to calculate the new reorder point.
